QUERI Implementation Strategy Learning Hubs

The goal of the QUERI Implementation Strategy Learning Hubs is to demystify implementation science by offering opportunities for clinicians and researchers to learn how to deploy effective practices using specific implementation strategies (i.e., tools or methods that help existing providers adopt effective practices). https://www.queri.research.va.gov/training_hubs/default.cfm

QUERI Learning Hubs use evidence-based implementation strategies and are coordinated by the Center for Evaluation and Implementation Resources (CEIR). CEIR is designed to provide time-sensitive consultation and support to VA operational leaders on evaluation and implementation methods to enable scale up and spread of policies and clinical practices aligned with one or more of the five VA priorities (Greater Choice for Veterans, Modernize Our Systems, Focus Resources More Efficiently, Improve Timeliness of Services, Suicide Prevention). **Designing for Dissemination and Implementation (D4D&I) Training Hub**, Cathy Battaglia, PhD, RN, PI - The D4D&I Training Hub will increase the knowledge and skills of those who are ready to disseminate and implement care coordination programs across diverse clinical settings and Veteran populations.
